Scripture Reading- 2Thessalonians 1:1-4, 11-12

Paul, Silas, and Timothy,

To the church of Thessalonians in God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ: ²Grace and peace to you from God the Father and the LORD Jesus Christ. ³We ought always to thank God for you, brothers and sisters, and rightly so, because your faith is growing more and more, and the love all of you have for one another is increasing. ⁴Therefore, among God's churches we boast about your perseverance and faith in all the persecutions and trials you are enduring. ¹¹With this in mind, we constantly pray for you, that our God may make you worthy of his calling, and that by his power he may bring to fruition your every desire for goodness and your every deed prompted by faith. ¹²We pray this so that the name of our Lord Jesus may be glorified in you, and you in him, according to the grace of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ.

Message: Pastor Pablo R. Vargas: "Increasing Faith, Increasing Love"

Sermon Notes (Just Some Thoughts):

- Paul writes 1 and 2 Thessalonians to a newly formed church in the city of Thessalonica
- The letters are intended to aid the Christians there in the ongoing formation of their life together in Christ in the midst of persecution.
- Paul's initial greeting is an indication that God is at work in the world- God's grace given to us leads us to peace: peace within ourselves and peace among us. It is a reminder that God's peace (shalom) is not a peace the same as the peace that was proclaimed by Rome (pax Romana) nor is it the peace that is proclaimed by the world's super powers, including our own nation.
- "Peace through strength" would never have been Jesus' motto.
- The Prince of Peace, contrary to Pax Romana, was not a peace through might of weapons or might of economic wealth but one achieved by AGAPE love- a love that can only be described as a selfless, unconditional, sacrificial and the highest form of love.
- Paul isn't only impressed by the increasing faith of the saints in Thessalonica, he is ecstatic over their increasing love.
- Paul is declaring that the Church in Thessalonica is increasing in their AGAPE love!
