"Pastoral Welcome & Prayer (Psalm 46)

Scripture Reading- **Jeremiah 23:1-6**

23 Woe to the shepherds who destroy and scatter the sheep of my pasture! says the LORD. ² Therefore thus says the LORD, the God of Israel, concerning the shepherds who shepherd my people: It is you who have scattered my flock and have driven them away, and you have not attended to them. So I will attend to you for your evil doings, says the LORD. ³ Then I myself will gather the remnant of my flock out of all the lands where I have driven them, and I will bring them back to their fold, and they shall be fruitful and multiply. ⁴ I will raise up shepherds over them who will shepherd them, and they shall no longer fear or be dismayed, nor shall any be missing, says the LORD. ⁵ The days are surely coming, says the LORD, when I will raise up for David a righteous Branch, and he shall reign as king and deal wisely and shall execute justice and righteousness in the land. ⁶ In his days Judah will be saved, and Israel will live in safety. And this is the name by which he will be called: "The LORD is our righteousness."

Sermon Notes (Just Some Thoughts):

- Jeremiah is writing to the exiles in Babylon
- The first wave of deportations begin around 597 BC and culminates in the destruction of Jerusalem.
- Nebuchadnezzar changed Mathias, Josiah's son to Zedekiah (2 Kings 24:8–17).
- The Babylonians installed Zedekiah, whose name means "the Lord is righteous" as a puppet king.

- Zedekiah who rules for 10 years with relative peace but then is urged to revolt against the Babylonians and is badly defeated.
- They murder all of his sons and blind Zedekiah.
